Grand Jury Inspection of Columbia County Detention Center

On January 9, 2025, three members of the Grand Jury visited the Columbia County Detention Center. We were briefed by Captain John Sherman about the operations, procedures, and physical facility of the Detention Center. There are separate male and female areas and levels of detention in those areas are based on the severity of the crimes committed and on inmate behavior while housed in the Center. We viewed several levels of detention and toured the medical area and the resident intake area. We did not visit the female area. Consistent staffing levels remain problematic for the administration. We ate a very good lunch in the dining facility and met Sheriff Whittle while there.

All staff were professional and serious about their responsibilities. Leadership interacted well with their staff members and inmates. The Center was well organized and disciplined and every area we visited was in good repair, neat, orderly and well maintained. Other than staffing challenges, we found no deficiencies.

It is our opinion that the Columbia County Detention Center is an excellent facility, the residents are well cared for, and that the Center is a great asset to our community, our Law Enforcement organization and staff, and other members of Columbia County public service work force.
