NARRATIVE

On the above date I made contact with Mrs. Marasco in reference to an altercation she said happened at their marital home on 4734 West Creek Mill Court in Grovetown. She stated her husband, Mr. Wittrock, texted her calling her names that upset her. She said an altercation ensued and he drug her through the house and through some spilled cat water. She stated she was trying to record him and he grabbed her phone and threw it in the crock pot filled with water in the sink. She did not have any signs of a physical altercation other than a small cut inbetween her fingers. There was no red marks or bruising on her shins or arms or face like she alleged. She stated she could not call the Sheriff's Office at that time since her phone was wet and would not work.

I then went to the address on West Creek Mill and made contact with Mr. Wittrock. He stated he was dead asleep when he heard his wife in his room clearing everything off the top of his dresser in one swipe. He stated he yelled at her to get out and said the two argued then she went out to smoke a cigarette. He stated she came back inside and kicked the cats water bowl making it spill in the hallway. He stated he yelled telling her to leave or that he would leave.

Other than the water being wiped up there was no other sign of a struggle, he had deleted his texts and there was no proof of any incoming or outgoing texts. Due to conflicting statements and lack of evidence, I was unable to determine who the aggressor was.
